This is a real interesting short video that Chris recorded with Placitas resident Master Gardener, Marc Davidson, showing the difference between planting a potted nursery tree, that tend to have girdled roots from growing in the pot, and planting the second similar tree after performing some root manicuring – washing, trimming, spreading the roots and replanting with fresh soil. Now 18 years later, look at the difference!! Marc used Afghan Pines, Scotch Pines and Arizona Cypress. Enjoy, and thank you, Chris!!
